**FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN PERILAKU
PEMERIKSAAN IVA TEST PADA IBU PKK DI DESA SUNGAI RAYA
DALAM TAHUN 2025**

ABSTRAK

Latar belakang : Pemeriksaan Inspeksi Visual Asam Asetat (IVA) adalah pemeriksaan skrining kanker serviks dengan cara inspeksi visual pada serviks dengan pemberian asam asetat. Berdasarkan data WHO 660.000 perempuan terdiagnosis kanker serviks di dunia dan 350.000 kematian. Berdasarkan data profil dinas kesehatan Kalimantan Barat 10% dari tabel WUS yang sudah periksa IVA. Berdasarkan studi pendahuluan dari 10 orang Ibu PKK, 7 orang diantaranya belum periksa IVA.

Tujuan : Untuk mengetahui Faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan perilaku pemeriksaan IVA test pada Ibu PKK di Desa Sungai Raya Dalam tahun 2025.

Metode : Jenis penelitian kuantitatif menggunakan desain survei analitik dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Subjek penelitian yaitu ibu PKK sebanyak 35 responden. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan total sampling. Instrumen penelitian kuesioner. Teknik Analisa menggunakan uji statistik *chi-square*.

Hasil : Perilaku pemeriksaan IVA test masih rendah (77,1%). Hasil analisa bivariat didapatkan hubungan signifikan antara pendidikan ($p\text{-value}=0,012$), pekerjaan ($p\text{-value}=0,007$), pengetahuan ($p\text{-value}=0,001$), sikap ($p\text{-value}=0,029$) dan dukungan keluarga/suami ($p\text{-value}=0,000$) dengan perilaku pemeriksaan IVA test. Sedangkan tidak ada hubungan antara jarak fasilitas kesehatan ($p\text{-value}=0,418$) dengan perilaku pemeriksaan IVA test pada ibu PKK di Desa Sungai Raya Dalam tahun 2025.

Kesimpulan : Ada hubungan antara pendidikan ($p = 0,012$), pekerjaan ($p = 0,007$), pengetahuan ($p=0,001$), sikap ($p=0,029$) dan dukungan keluarga/suami ($p=0,000$).

Saran : Diharapkan tenaga kesehatan meningkatkan pembekalan kepada kader kesehatan dan melibatkan kader untuk melakukan penyuluhan tentang deteksi dini kanker serviks dengan metode IVA.

ABSTRACT

Background: Acetic Acid Visual Inspection (IVA) is a screening examination of cervical cancer by means of visual inspection of the cervix with the administration of acetic acid. Based on data from the World Health Organization (WHO), 660,000 women have been diagnosed with cervical cancer in the world and 350,000 deaths. Based on the profile data of the West Kalimantan health office, 10% of the WUS table has been checked for IVA. Based on a preliminary study of 10 PKK women, 7 of them have not checked IVA.

Purposive: To find out the factors related to the behavior of the IVA test examination in PKK women in Sungai Raya Dalam Village in 2025.

Method: This type of quantitative research uses an analytical survey design with a cross sectional approach. The subjects of the study were PKK mothers as many as 35 respondents. The sampling technique uses total sampling. Questionnaire research instrument. The analysis technique uses a chi-square statistical test.

Results: The behavior of IVA test examinations is still low (77.1%). The results of the bivariate analysis found a significant relationship between education (p-value = 0.012), work (p-value = 0.007), knowledge (p-value = 0.001), attitude (p-value = 0.029) and family/husband support (p-value = 0.000) and IVA test behavior. Meanwhile, there was no relationship between the distance of health facilities (p-value = 0.418) and the behavior of IVA test examinations in PKK mothers in Sungai Raya Dalam Village in 2025.

Conclusion: There was a relationship between education (p = 0.012), employment (p = 0.007), knowledge (p = 0.001), attitude (p = 0.029) and family/husband support (p = 0.000).

Suggestion: It is hoped that health workers will increase debriefing to health cadres and involve cadres to conduct counseling on early detection of cervical cancer using the IVA method.
